

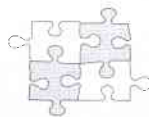

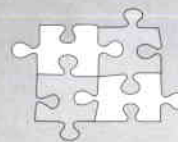

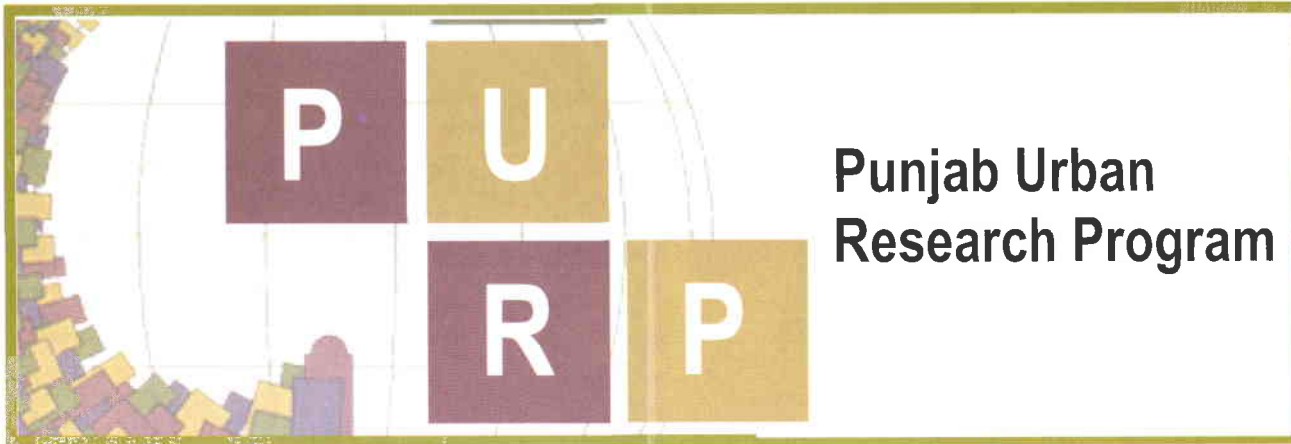
# **Punjab Urban Research Program**
